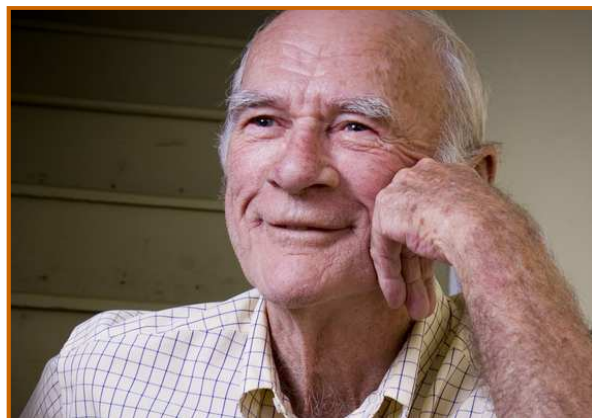


## EDEXCEL LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP IN HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE (QCF 79 CREDITS)

The apprenticeship framework contributes towards developing a social care sector with a skilled, flexible and effective workforce whilst maintaining high quality and safe care for those who use services. Through completion of this apprenticeship learners will gain broad-base training in their chosen occupational area with a broad knowledge base of the sector as a whole, work experience that leads to competency in the work place and transferable skills. Learners will undertake the following qualifications to complete the apprenticeship framework;

- > Key Skills in Literacy (QCF 5 Credits)
- > Key Skills in Mathematics (QCF 5 Credits)
- > Edexcel Level 2 Diploma in Health & Social Care (Adults for England) (QCF 46 Credits)
- > Edexcel Level 2 Certificate in Preparing to Work in Adult Social Care (QCF 20 Credits)
- > Employer Rights and Responsibilities (QCF 3 Credits)



### Who is this course suitable for?

This is the sole apprenticeship Framework for people employed in delivering adult social care in England. It provides a suitable way to meet the development and qualification needs of a variety of roles and job titles, including care workers, community support and outreach workers, personal assistants, domiciliary care workers, supervisors and senior care workers. As well as being suitable for existing staff, this framework gives apprentices extensive opportunities to gain employment in the social care sector as well as in some health care roles.

In the health sector this framework is suitable for healthcare assistants or clinical support workers. This framework supports the broad vision of the sector to develop an increasingly skilled flexible and effective workforce & addresses specific outcomes of the Skills for Health Sector Skills Assessment 2011

### Do I need any experience?

No experience is necessary however candidates will need to be employed within the care sector as the Diploma is partially competency based.

### How is the qualification delivered?

The programme is delivered over a period of 9 – 12 months and the delivery model is based on an established “Learn by Doing” methodology, delivered on your site.

### What will I gain from this course?
